# **IIM Shillong Golf Cup**

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

IIM Shillong Golf Cup, an Inter B School Golf Tournament, is a Handicap Tournament open to all Post\_ Graduate Business School students, faculty, alumni and associates and is in the form of a Team Event.

Each team will consist of three competitors, comprising students or combination of students and faculty members. A team can also be formed in combination of faculty members/staff/alumni and associates. Each team will be required to play one/two rounds and total of the two best net scores of each round played by the team will be the team score. In the event of a tie third score will be considered.

Those who are unable to form a team to participate in this tournament, may enter as individual competitors, or as a part team, and will be formed into a full team by the Tournament Committee.

There are number of prizes for both team and individual performances.

### **Conditions**

The Tournament will be open to both ladies and gentlemen with recognized Club Handicap only.

### **Amateur Status**

The status of Amateur Golfer is as defined by Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.

### **Handicaps**

- a) The lowest and latest USGA Handicap will be applicable.
- b) The maximum handicap for gentlemen will be 24 and for ladies 30.

### **Scoring**

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Local Rules as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and in accordance with the local rules approved by the Tournament Committee.

### **Dispute**

Any dispute during the Tournament shall be referred to the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final.

Local Rules of Shillong Golf Club shall apply.
